First Place: *Shades Park* by Robert L. Heger

Friday evening, March 18th, saw the opening of the 15th Annual Grand WAA Bash juried art show. Several members of the community attended the opening reception, held from 7:00 to 9:00 pm, and enjoyed a variety of refreshments as they examined and enjoyed the works of art on display in the Wells Galleries.

About midway through the festivities, the winning pieces were announced. A beautiful 30 x 36 pastel (pictured above) entitled *Shades Park* by artist Robert L. Heger won first place.

Second place was awarded to a unique watercolor by Kathryn Clark entitled *Two Fish Skeletons II* (pictured to the right).

Also of interest: according to a usually reliable source (Leon) Kathryn has a very interesting article on Twin Rocker in the 2005 edition of *Drawing* (a publication of *American Arts Magazine*). Check it out.

Third place in the competition went to Scott Frankenberger for his porcelain piece entitled *Extruded Teapot*.

Finally, the Juror's Choice Award went to Judie Huth for her pastel entitled *The Valley Below*.
